Oil Creek wetlands are working!

Final inspection of the Oil Creek Phase 1 restoration was conducted in early October. YCRTA representatives, engineers, and contractors waded through the waters (in the far distance of the photo above) to inspect the site's stabilization and water flow. Squawking killdeer circling overhead, small fish darting underfoot, and water percolating up from underground springs proved that these wetlands are coming alive. Work will now begin to create a section of the Hanover Trolley Trail to introduce visitors to this wet world.



Humble beginnings for trail extension into Heidelberg Township

From the back of a pick-up truck, engineers and contractors review the construction drawings just prior to the start of building a 1-mile extension to the Hanover Trolley Trail. A section of the rail corridor east of Gitts Run Road has been cleared and designated as the construction entrance for contractor W Craig Adams, and the corridor is closed to the public. Work will continue through 2025.
